

# 1996 National strategy: "Our collective responsibility"



- Reduce “every-day” crime by focusing on the situation. For example the relation between alcohol and violence. (Where, when and how)
- Reduce the recruitment to criminal lifestyle (Who)
- Reduce the criminal activity among recidivists. (Who)
